



Bob's Grill servers remember Casey Feldman

All of the servers at Bob's Grill wore pink t-shirts last week, July 17, the one-year anniversary of Casey Feldman's tragic death. Feldman, 21, of Springfield, Pa., worked at Bob's Grill during the summer. She was a student at Fordham University where she was studying journalism. She was killed when a vehicle hit her while crossing Central Avenue on her way to work. The pink t-shirts worn by the servers at Bob's Grill remind motorists and pedestrians to exercise due caution when on the roads. The servers are standing in front of the pink remembrance tree that is dedicated in Casey Anderson Feldman's name and stands in memory of those involved in fatal car accidents.
